

AT

consider, examine closely

*"I **looked at** the possibility of buying a new car, but my current one still runs great and it's paid off."*

AFTER

watch or protect; to keep safe

*"He asked me to **look after** his daughter while he was away."*

AROUND

search a place or inspect a building / area

*"I can't find my keys, so I'll **look around** the house."*

FOR

search for; to seek

*"He spent his life **looking for** the truth."*

INTO

investigate, explore or consider

*"If you are buying a new car, you might want to **look into** getting a hybrid vehicle."*

FORWARD TO

think with pleasure about something

*"I'm **looking forward to** my birthday party."*

LOOK

BACK AT/ON

look again at sth to remind yourself, think about past

*"I enjoy **looking back at** the good old days."*

ON

watch; to observe

*"My performance seems somehow always to get worse when there are other people **looking on**."*

UP

have better prospects, to improve, search for information

*"Things started **looking up** after Tom moved back in with his parents."*

OUT

look from within to the outside

*"**Look out**, and you will see the rain has stopped."*
