to get rid of; remove; put an end to, kill
sb

*"I wish we could **do away with** poverty."*

WITHOUT

to succeed in living or working
without someone or something

*"We'll have to **do without** Tom at today's meeting, he's on a business trip."*

DO

OVER

to do sth again, to clean or decorate
sth

*"I need to **do over** the bedroom. My wife doesn't like the colour of the walls."*

UP

To fasten something (usually clothes),
make something into a package

*"**Do up** your shoelaces or you might fall."*
