

## AFTER

to chase or follow

*"The policeman **made after** the thief."*

## FOR

to move toward something, help to make something possible

*"I got up from the chair and **made for** the door."*

## OVER

to renovate, legally give sth to sb, transform

*"The tailor **made over** her dress."*

## UP

to make peace, use cosmetics to make attractive, invent

*"I don't like conflicts and I prefer to **make up** after an argument."*

## OF

to understand the meaning of sth, think of sth / so

*"Can you **make of** anything of this information?"*

## OUT

to distinguish, write out a document

*"Can you **make out** who is beside the president?"*

# MAKE

## WAY

to allow somebody/something to pass, make progress

*"The area was bulldozed to **make way** for a new road."*

## UP FOR

to recover, make sth better, compensate

*"Nothing can **make up for** the loss of a child."*

## INTO

to change sb/sth into sth else

*"We **made** the living room **into** an office."*

## TOWARDS

to start moving towards sth/sb

*"She **made** her way **towards** the door."*
