

AWAY

avoid, to not come

*"He told them to **stay away** from him."*

IN

not go out

*"I'm going to **stay in** and chill tonight;
I can't be bothered to go out."*

UP

go to bed later than usual

*"The children **stayed up** until way past
their bedtime."*

ON

continue, remain longer than
anticipated

*"She **stayed on** after she graduated to
do a Master's degree."*

STAY

OVER

sleep overnight

*"I **stayed over** at a friend's house last
night because of the train strike."*

OUT

not go home, continue to be
outdoors, continue to be on strike

*"We **stayed out** all night."*
